



## Roll of Merit (R.O.M.) –as at January 2020

- ❖ The R.O.M. is an award system that runs for the life of the horse.
- ❖ There is a one off cost of \$60 to nominate your horse for the R.O.M.
- ❖ Once payment and nomination has been received you will receive your R.O.M. forms by mail.
- ❖ One form is to be filled out for each judge/result at each show. No signatures are required.
- ❖ Only the horse's best led and ridden performance (including Champion/Reserve) gained under any one judge, on any one day, in palomino classes will be counted.
- ❖ Points are allocated as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	6 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	4 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	2 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	1 point
Champion	10 points
Reserve Champion	8 points

Our State Show is double points of the above.
- ❖ The led and ridden points are separate and are each working towards the 3 levels of achievement.
  1. NSW Palomino Society Inc. Certificate
  2. NSW Palomino Society Inc. Bronze Plaque
  3. NSW Palomino Society Inc. Bronze Horse's Head



- ❖ Points can be transferred on sale of horse.
- ❖ Ridden points cannot be counted until the horse is aged 3 years old.
- ❖ Forms **MUST** be returned to the R.O.M. keeper within 30 days of the show.
